Cold War era Mosin Nagant rifle. 20 3/4" 7.62x54R cal barrel with original sights and folding bayonet. Chamber with 1952 date and Radom arsenal mark. Metalwork has near all bright blue finish with only minor staining on the white metal bolt handle. ExC original woodwork complete with original sling, small area of loss to the blue on the butt plate. ExWO&C ALR

WWII British Military No5 carbine. 20 1/2" .303 cal barrel with original flash hider, sight and bayonet lug. The rear with tangent and aperture sight. Marked NO5 MK1 ROF (F) with March 1945 date. Most thinning original Military enamel finish. Bolt and receiver are matching. VGC woodwork. VGWO&C ALR

17 - SWEDISH M38 MAUSER RIFLE

WWII era short version of the M96 rifle. 24" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights. Chamber marked Husqvarna 1942 etc with matching serial number on turned down type bolt. Thinning overall original blue with staining to the white metal. GC woodwork complete with stock disc, sling and rod. VGWO&C ALR

18 - JUNGLE CARBINE BAYONET

British bayonet for the No5 carbine. 20cm blued blade with ordnance and Wilkinson makers mark. VGC wooden grips, complete with scabbard. ExC

Metalwork has most original thinning blue turning grey where holstered at the front of the slide. Worn but original grips. Correct but mismatched magazine. GWO&C B/CLR

22 - HI-POWER PISTOL

WWII Chinese Military contract Canadian made M35 pistol. 4 3/4" 9mm cal barrel, the slide with tangent rear sight and marked BROWNING - F.N 9mm HP INGLIS CANADA. Slide and frame are mismatched but correct CH prefix. Metalwork has pin pricking on the slide above the legend and some loss to grey of the parkerising on the opposite central slide section. GC bakelite grips with lanyard ring and two correct Inglis magazines plus a post war web holster. GWO&C B/CLR

23 - ARTILLERY LUGER PISTOL

Imperial German WWI LP08. 8" 9mm cal barrel with original sights, serial number and test proof. The chamber is dated 1916 and proofed on the side. All visible numbers including the magazine are matching. Metalwork has most overall blue finish that has turned plum around the rear sides of the frame. There is scattered pin pricking to areas of the gun. GC original grips. GWO&C B/CLR

24 - LUGER PISTOL

A WWI era P08 with 4 1/2" replacement barrel in .30 Luger caliber. The chamber dated 1918 and has Crown/N proof. The toggle has had the makers logo and Military proofs removed. Metalwork has most overall blue including the safety and trigger. Replacement modern grips and WWI magazine. F-GWO&C B/CLR

25 - SWEDISH '07 PISTOL

Swedish Military Browning M1907 pistol. 5" 9mm Browning long cal barrel, slide with original sights and Husqvarna address. Metalwork with near all Military finish. VGC original grips with Swedish Crown. VG-ExWO&C B/CLR

British Military WWI double action revolver. 6" .455 cal with original sights and ordnance marked. Frame dated 1916 and has Webley patent mark. Metalwork has near all aged Military re-blue, VGC checkered grips, missing the lanyard ring. G-VGWO&C B/CLR

Dark brown leather original hard-shell holster for the German P08 pistol. Makers mark and 1917 dated. VGC

The receiver marked Crown/VR 1870 III I. Metalwork has traces of blue woodwork with some chipping where the action meets the butt on the right hand side. Complete with rod and swivels. GWO&C ALR

34 - TURKISH MARTINI RIFLE

Turkish Military Martini Enfield and breech loading rifle. 30" .303 cal barrel with original sights, ordnance and newer British proofs. Receiver marked Citadel 1905. Most overall blue, GC woodwork but missing middle swivel. VGWO&C ALR

35 - SNIDER CARBINE

NZ Military Artillery carbine. 21 1/2" 577 cal ordnance marked barrel with carbine rear and front sight. The bayonet lug appears to be shaved down. The front of the lock marked N81Z C and the plate marked 1880 Bonehill etc. Metalwork with dark patina. GC woodwork with brass furniture, swivels and rod. G-VGWO&C ALR

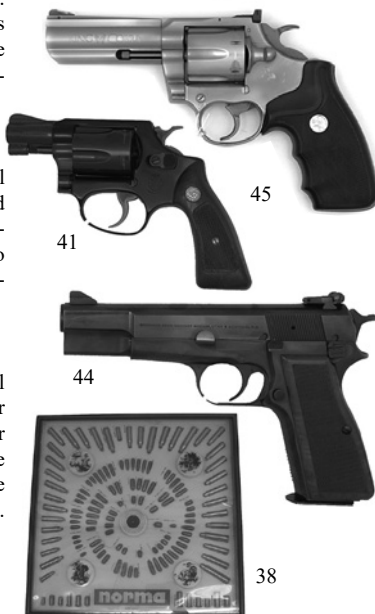

Lock plate marked 1861 ENFIELD & Crown VR. Metalwork with dark patina. GC woodwork with swivels, rod and chain. G-VGWO&C ALR

Superb example of a WWII, circa 1942-44, US Military Winchester manufactured M1 Carbine. 18" .30M1 cal barrel with original sights. The chamber is marked U.S. CARBINE CAL .30 M1. The rear has correct flip up aperture sight and Winchester logo. The gun also has correct push safety. Metalwork has all over parkerised finish. ExC correct Winchester high wood stock with sharp inspectors cartouche. Complete with sling and oiler plus 15R magazine. This gun appears to be in un-issued condition. Hard to find better! WWII era NZ issue MKII Sten S.M.G. 8" 9mm cal barrel marked with NZ prefix serial number. The receiver with original sights and the magazine well is marked STEN MKII/FA prefix serial number/additional NZ prefix number. The underside is marked SECO for Sterling subcontractor. The gun is also marked CR ↑. Near all enamel finish, fitted with T stock. Includes two magazines and loading tool. ExWO&C C/P7

57 - THOMPSON ACCESSORY SET

Original WWII era accessories for the M1 and M1A1. Includes spare parts bag, rod, oil bottle, brush, spring and guide, buffer and ejector. ExC CLR

is early ball type and the serial number is in the late 4,000 range for first year of manufacture. Metalwork has overall original blue finish which is still bright in areas. Some slight bruising in a few places. GC original grips with some chipping at the base and handling marks. Action indexes, retaining pin is slightly at fault, otherwise VGWO&C NLR

61 - COLT 1860 ARMY REVOLVER

Antique U.S Civil War percussion revolver, circa 1863. 8" .44 cal round barrel with original sight and New York address. The cylinder has traces of the scene and clear patent and serial number which is matching in the 131,000 range. Metalwork has grey overall patina with some staining. Most of the screw heads are tidy and the butt is cut for a shoulder stock. Gun is marked COLTS PATENT on the frame and has several inspectors marks including the cartouche on the walnut grips. Action is strong & indexes well. VGWO&C NLR

62 - COLT POCKET REVOLVER

Antique U.S Model 1849 Pocket percussion revolver, circa 1867. 5" octagonal .31 cal barrel with original bead sight and one line New York address, 6 shot cylinder has most visible stage coach scene. The frame is marked COLT'S PATENT and 31 CAL in the guard. Metalwork has areas of bright blue to the barrel with visible case colours to the rod, frame and hammer, particularly where concealed, edges and screws are sharp with some areas of bruising. The brass trigger guard and back strap have no traces of nickel silver. All numbers including the wedge are matching in the 290,000 range. ExC original grips with near all varnish. Action is strong and indexes well. VGWO&C NLR

63 - COLT POCKET REVOLVER

Antique U.S Model 1849 pocket percussion revolver, circa 1854. 5" Octagonal .31 cal barrel with original bead sight and early two line New York address. Five shot cylinder has most of the stage coach scene visible. The frame is marked COLTS PATENT. Metalwork has all over grey patina and traces of nickel inside the brass trigger guard. VGC original wooden grips with some bruising. All serial numbers are matching in the 99,000 range. Action is strong and indexes well. GWO&C NLR

64 - REPRODUCTION COLT CASE

Modern made wooden reproduction case with red velvet lining for the 1860 Army. Includes an old reproduction Colt flask and a bullet mold (no key). GC

70 - FOLDING BOWIE

Antique large folding Bowie by famous German knife manufacturer Friedrich Herder, circa mid-late 19th Century. 19 3/4cm clip point blade with the Solingen makers mark. The cross guard is nickel silver and the scales are antler and secured by pins. Includes its original leather sheath. Some age staining to the blade otherwise Ex-C

71 - COLT S/A REVOLVER

Model 1873 single action Army revolver, circa 1907. 5 1/2" .32WCF cal barrel with original sight, one line Hartford address and 32WCF as well as British proofs (also on the chamber). The frame has patent information and Rampant Colt logo. Metalwork has original bright blue to the barrel and cylinder with some edge loss and the grip straps have thinned where held. The frame and hammer still have areas of case colours. The grips are replacement American Eagle. ExWO&C B/CLR

72 - COLT S/A REVOLVER

Antique U.S Model 1873 Single Action Army revolver, circa 1892. 4 3/4" .41 cal barrel with original sights and correct two line address and stamped 41 COLT. The frame with patent and rampant Colt logo. Metalwork has nice original dark patina. All visible numbers are matching. Original brown hard rubber grips have worn smooth in areas and a scuff to the left hand side. Action is strong. VGWO&C B/CLR

73 - COLT BISLEY REVOLVER

U.S Bisley variant of the 1873 S/A revolver, circa 1905. 4 3/4" .41 cal barrel with original sight and marked with two line Hartford address and (BISLEY MODEL) 41 COLT. The frame with patent information and rampant Colt logo. Metalwork has thin overall blue turning dark grey in areas. VGC original checkered rubber grips. Action is strong. VGWO&C B/CLR

74 - MOORE'S PATENT REVOLVER

A fine example of a scarce U.S Moore's Patent single action revolver, circa 1861-64. 4" .32RF cal octagonal barrel with original sight and marked D.MOORE.PATENT. SEPT * 18 - 1860. The cylinder is 7 shot and pivots with the barrel to the right to load. The frame and straps are silver plated with scroll engraving. The cylinder has near all bright blue and the barrel is turning plum and has sharp edges. ExC walnut original grips. These were a short lived popular competitor to S&W's early cartridge pistols and saw use in the U.S Civil War. This is a superb example and even includes its extremely rare original cardboard box with hand written inscription and 1864 date. ExWO&C CLR

75 - S&W NO.2 REVOLVER

U.S single action No2 old model revolver, circa 1861. 5" .32RF cal octagonal ribbed barrel with original sight and marked SMITH & WESSON . SPRINGFIELD MASS. Six shot round cylinder with patent information the frame is early model with two cylinder stop pins and has three digit serial number. Metalwork has areas of bright blue to most of the frame and has turned dark grey on the barrel. ExC original rosewood grips. These were a popular U.S Civil War pistol and one was also famously carried by "Wild Bill" Hickok while Marshal of Deadwood. VG-ExWO&C CLR

76 - SPENCER CARBINE

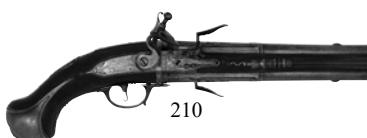

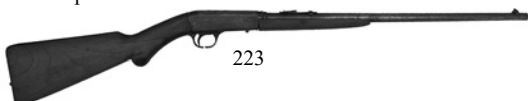

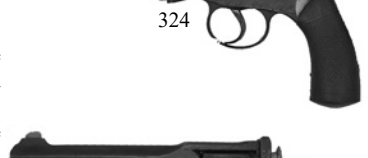

All firearms, parts and ammunition (excluding antique) require a mail order form from a Police Officer validating your license. This form is forwarded on your behalf to us from your local Arms Officer / Police station. Pistols & restricted weapons require a permit to procure before delivery

EXPORT – We can export to most countries. Firearms including antique have to be exported via air freight. We have a freight forwarder who can organise this for you. An export license will need to be obtained. We charge a \$80 fee for our time in organising the export and packaging. The freight forwarder will charge you for the NZ export license and the freight for the firearm(s). This is usually charged forward and you will pay this on receiving your goods. The export process can take around 4-8 weeks. For an estimate of the export license and freight charges please contact us. NZ G.S.T (VAT/sales tax) is only on the commission / buyers premium portion of the items, because this service occurs in New Zealand this must be charged on exports. Items that are not firearms can be sent via NZ postal service and will be charged at that rate plus packaging. Some items with historical significance to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.
