Two 10 cell model 1923 type ammo belts for the Garand/ Springfield rifles. One is khaki and U.S marked on one of the cells as well as a hard to make out makers mark and 1943? date. The second looks to be later darker green and U.S marked on flap. FC

Two Bianchi UM84/92 Military green web flap holsters for compact Beretta pistols and a double mag pouch. ExC

5 - COLT AND S&W GRIPS

Five assorted revolver grips, including original COLT logo model 1892 Army grips, Colt emblem small frame detective special and two aftermarket rubber S&W grips. GC

20 - SWEDISH M38 RIFLE

Swedish Military bolt action Mauser rifle. 24" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights and correctly threaded for BFA. Chamber is marked Carl Gustafs etc 1913 and bolt handle is straight type. Metalwork has most overall blue. GC woodwork with swivels. GWO&C ALR

21 - JAPANESE ARISAKA BAYONET

WWII type 30 bayonet. 40cm blade is in VGC, unsharpened, no pitting with blueing present but worn. Marked with triangle and Nagoya Arsenal meaning its made by Asian Kogyo under Nagoya. Hilt has wooden grips with some chips and dents, crossguard has hooked quillon and muzzle ring. VGC original blued steel scabbard. VGC

22 - JAPANESE FOLDING BAYONET

Rare Military bayonet for Type 44 cavalry carbine. 35cm blued blade with side mounted quillon. Bayonet is attached to front wood of the rifle (included) and has a push button to fold the bayonet. Hard to find example for the discerning collector. ExC

23 - GERMAN K98 BAYONET

WWII Military Mauser bayonet. 25cm ExC original blued blade code marked 42asw. ExC 9 groove bakelite grips with flashguard. Scabbard is blued steel and in ExC. ExC

24 - NO4 CRUCIFORM BAYONET

Rare 1st variant of the No4 MKI Spike bayonet for the WWII SMLE rifle. 20cm Cruciform shaped blade marked at the base GMR.NO4 MKI/RM. Complete with correct early type steel scabbard, both with near all original blued finish. ExC

25 - VZ 22 PISTOL

Scarce early Czech Military semi auto pistol based on the Joseph Nickel design. 3½" 9mm N short cartridge barrel, side with external extractor and original sights. The frame is marked 9mm N/Cs. st. zbrojovka.Brno. The grip strap is unit marked 23.P.114. Metalwork has all over thinning original blue with some staining. GC original wooden grips with lanyard ring. Finnish Military issued Italian Beretta M1934 pistol. 3¼" .380acp cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked with calibre and Beretta address with 1942 date. The frame has SA Finnish acceptance mark. Metalwork has near all original blue thinning on the edges and slide. VGC original grips. VGWO&C CLR

27 - ENFIELD No.2 REVOLVER

British Military WWII era No2MKI* 'Tanker' model double action only revolver. 5". 38 S&W cal barrel with original sight and marked with calibre plus broad arrow on top. The frame is marked No2 MKI* 1942 and has Australian manufacturer logo for Howard Auto Cultivator. Most thinning original blue. VGC original bakelite grips. VGWO&C B/CLR

28 - WWII LUGER PISTOL

Nazi German P08 pistol, circa early 1941. 4" 9mm cal barrel with original sight, serial number and test proof. The chamber has two digit 41 date and marked on the side with test and eagle 655 proofs. The toggle is code marked byf for Mauser. The frame is stamped P08. Metalwork retains near all its original salt blue including the small parts with some handling wear to the side plate. All visible numbers are matching. ExC original walnut grips. Complete with blued body magazine without markings or proofs with black plastic base and has a section of pitting to the spine. 29 - WWI LUGER PISTOL

Imperial German P08. 4" 9mm cal barrel with original sights, proof and serial number. The chamber dated 1917 and the toggle marked Erfurt with all correct proofs. 30 - COLT 1911 PISTOL

U.S WWI semi auto pistol. 5".45 ACP cal barrel. The front sight has been shaved down and the rear is correct. Slide marked with Colt Hartford address and patent as well as MODEL OF 1911 U.S ARMY. The frame is marked with Military range serial number for 1918. Metalwork has overall old reblue and has dark grey patina with all over pin pricking with several areas of deeper pitting. Worn original wooden diamond pattern grips, the magazine appears to be a later type with lanyard ring base fitted. FWO&C B/CLR

31 - WWII LUGER HOLSTER

A Nazi era brown leather hard shell hoster. Marked on the back with a Waffen amt and BRESCAU maker with a clear 1939 date. Field repair on belt loops. Overall in GC.

32 - WWI POLICE LUGER HOLSTER

Seldom seen black leather Police style holster for the Imperial German P08. Has Police style closure reversed from standard Military. Inside flap has Ulm makers mark and 1918. The rear of the holster Crown/L and Police number 9188 (most likely Military Police). Repair to a belt loop and magazine pouch. VGC

33 - LUGER BOOK

LUGER: The Multi National Pistol by Kenyon. Hard cover, large format, colour and B&W photos, 185 pages covering virtually all models of the iconic pistol. An excellent reference book in ExC.

A rare NZ 1 of 1000 Armaf MKI Sten Guns produced in NZ for the Air Force during WWII. The 8" 9mm cal barrel has been plugged at the chamber at some point to deactivate the gun. Ventilated shroud and original sight. The magazine well is marked with the Air Department Crown and SER.601 1942 ARMAF MKI. The gun is also marked NZ 2910 NPZ. The original bolt is also NZ marked with Enfield drawing number. Matching serial number at the rear of the gun. Near all parkerised finish. Correct T style stock and 32R magazine. VGC C&P7LR

37 - MKI BREN GUN

British Military WWII Bren Light machine gun. 21".303 cal barrel with blued flash hider, sights and carry handle. The barrel has been numbered to the gun in electric pencil. The chamber is marked U.S Carbine CAL .30 M2 (small 2 not overstamp). The rear with adjustable sight and INLAND manufacturers mark and serial number. Left side of receiver has two position selector. Metalwork has all over original parkerised finish. VGC original woodwork with old professional armourers repair on the underside of the wrist as well as 51 rack number on the grip. U.S Military WWII semi auto carbine. 18".30M1 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug fitted. Marked UNDER-WOOD 2-44 date and flying bomb. The chamber marked U.S CARBINE CAL .30M1. Original British Military Ordnance marked MKI canvas sling for the Bren gun VGC

Forward pistol grip for the MK3 Bren gun as used in the Jungle. New made item in ExC

Scarce Anti Aircraft sight for the Bren range of light machine guns. VGC

Original WWII sling for the Mauser carbine. 1940 date with cgu code mark and Waffen amt stamp. GC

44 - AA MOUNT

Mount to fit MG34. Modified from most likely a Yugo M53 AA mount with reproduction top fitting for a MG34. Most dark olive green paint. GC

45 - CHEYENNE CARBINE

Winchester commemorative model 94 lever action. 20" 44-40 cal round barrel with full mag and original sights with hood, retains all bright blue. Marked with Winchester logo and calibre. The receiver with a tang sight fitted is gold plated and engraved with Indian scenes. ExC original woodwork. Includes its original box with a tear and some writing to the slip cover otherwise ExWO&C ALR

Metalwork has allover original blue to the barrel and slide and alloy frame retains all finish. ExC brown original plastic grips with NEW PUMA model and logo. VGWO&C CLR

56 - VZ50 PISTOL

Czech semi auto pistol, circa Cold War era. 3.6".32ACP cal barrel, slide with fixed sights and marked VZ0R CZ etc. and 1960 proof date. Near all original blued finish. ExC original













bakelite grips. ExWO&C CLR

57 - COLT '51 NAVY REVOLVER

An unusual period shortened barrel Colt 1851 Navy model percussion revolver, circa 1852. The .36 cal barrel has been shortened to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and has the brass pin sight at the end of the New York address. The hammer slot has been filled. Visible number except the wedge are matching in the 17,000 range. The frame has small Colts patent and the brass straps have the small oval guard and only minor traces of the nickel plating. Metalwork has gray speckled patina with traces of the cylinder scene. VGC original walnut grips. The Mormons were known to shorten barrels and these are commonly referred to as Avenging Angels. Action functions well. GWO&C NLR

58 - COLT '49 POCKET REVOLVER

Antique percussion model 1849 pocket revolver, circa 1867. 5".31 cal octagonal barrel with brass pin foresight and New York address as well as London proof marks on the side and each of the six cylinders. The frame is marked COLTS PAT-ENT. The straps are English style steel straps and marked on the bow 31 CAL. All numbers except the unnumbered wedge are matching in the 296,000 range. Metalwork has all over dark patina with traces of blue and cylinder scene. The edges are rounded and there is some bruising. VGC original walnut grips. G-VGWO&C NLR

59 - PEPPERBOX REVOLVER

Antique, circa 1830-50's percussion pepperbox double action revolver by Rogers & Co of London. $6x 2\frac{1}{2}$ " .31 cal fluted barrels with hard to make out proofs and most blue. The action is bar hammer type with recoil shed and retains near all its nickel silver finish. The side plates are scroll engraved as well as ROGERS & CO LONDON. The one piece checkered walnut grips show wear and action is at fault otherwise G-VGWO&C NLR

60 - ANTIQUE REVOLVER

A British percussion revolver, circa 1850/60's based on the Webley Bentley design. 5" 80 bore/.38 cal octagonal barrel marked ADAMS (most likely trying to pass this off as a better known maker of the day). The gun is Birmingham proofed on the barrel and each of the 5 cylinders. Open top design with double action only trigger. Frame has some borderline engraving and is also marked LONDON Patent No. 38618. Metalwork has grey overall patina. GC checkered original grips. GWO&C NLR

61 - TRANSITIONAL REVOLVER

Antique, circa 1840's , English percussion revolver. 4½" .38 cal/80 bore octagonal barrel marked HETHERINGTON NOTTINGHAM and is Birmingham proved on the underside 6 shot round cylinder and bar hammer, double action mechanism with engraved side plates and trigger guard. Metalwork has grey patina with faint case colours, finely checkered wooden grips with bullet trap base. Contained in an old homemade case with a nice small leather bound three way medicine bottle flask plus another bag shaped flask, mold and eley cap tin. VGWO&C NLR





EXPORT – We can export to most countries. Firearms including antique have to be exported via air freight. We have a freight forwarder who can organise this for you. An export license will need to be obtained. We charge a \$80 fee for our time in organising the export and packaging, The freight forwarder will charge you for the NZ export license and the freight for the firearm(s). This is usually charged forward and you will pay this on receiving your goods. The export process can take around 4-8 weeks. For an estimate of the export license and freight charges please contact us. NZ G.S.T (VAT/sales tax) is only on the commission / buyers premium portion of the items, because this service occurs in New Zealand this must be charged on exports. Items that are not firearms can be sent via NZ postal service and will be charged at that rate plus packaging. Some items with historical significance to New Zealand may not be able to be exported.
