Includes leather and steel scabbard. This is a high grade replica, without makers mark but possibly Paul Chen or similar quality. ExC

15 - MEDIEVAL SWORD

A good quality modern reproduction of a 14th Century sword, 70cm heavy wide triangular blade. Rounded iron guard with circular pommel and wire wrapped hand grip. Includes leather and brass scabbard.

NZ Military Lee Enfield Carbine. 21" .303 cal barrel with a replaced dovetail foresight and pattern 1888 bayonet lug and swivel. Correct rear sight graduated to 2000 yards and 500 on the bed. Chamber with proofs and sold out of service marks. Bolt is correct type but as often usual mismatched. The wrist is marked Crown VR/ENFIELD 1894, plus Crown ER ENFIELD 1903 L.E.C I*. The other side is marked N↑Z 1419/03. Metalwork has thin stained patina with areas of pin pricking. Woodwork with bruising and the top wood is a replacement and is without spring clip to secure it. Includes correct 6R magazine. FWO&C ALR

17 - NO1 MKIII RIFLE

Australian Military WWII SMLE. 25" .303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The wrist is marked MA Lithgow SMLE III* 1942, bolt is mismatched. Metalwork has overall dark blue. GC woodwork with swivels and stock disc. GWO&C ALR

18 - NO4 MK 1/3 RIFLE

WWII Lee Enfield bolt action rifle. 25" .303 cal barrel with bayonet lug and sight. Receiver with ladder type rear and marked No4 MKI* Longbranch 1943 with FTR and /3(F) FTR 1952 upgrade in electric pencil. Bolt and receiver are matching. Metalwork has all over finish. VGWO&C ALR

19 - JUNGLE CARBINE

British Military WWII Lee Enfield Carbine. 20" 303 cal barrel with flash hider and bayonet lug. The receiver with ladder rear sight and marked No5 MK.1 M/47c 1945 and serial number matching on the bolt. GC original early type woodwork. VGWO&C ALR

20 - TYPE 38 CARBINE

Imperial Japanese WWII Arisaka Carbine. 18¼" 6.5 JAP cal barrel with original winged foresight and V notch rear sight. The chamber without Mum but has dust cover and Nagoya arsenal mark. Metalwork has turned a dark overall patina. The woodwork is typical heavily bruised and complete with swivels and flat type butt plate. F-GWO&C ALR

21 - TYPE 38 RIFLE

Imperial Japanese WWII bolt action Arisaka rifle. 31" 6.5 JAP cal barrel with original winged foresight and V notch rear sight. Chamber marked in Kanji type 38 but the mum has been ground. Side rail with Kokura arsenal mark. Metalwork has all over bright blue to the receiver and barrel, thinning in a few areas and to grey on the magazine floor plate and trigger guard, the safety knob is the second small tang type. VGC original woodwork with flat steel butt plate swivels and rod. Without dust cover. VGWO&C ALR

22 - ARISAKA BAYONET

Imperial Japanese type 30 bayonet for the Arisaka rifles. 391/cm blade in the white with 3/4 length fuller and has Nagoya arsenal mark and some staining to the hooked quillon and pommel. Blued steel scabbard with a couple of dents. GC

23 - PATTERN 1888 BAYONET

British Military bayonet for the Long Tom or NZ Carbine. MK2 variant with oiler in the pommel and wide brass rivets. 30½cm blade with December 1900 date and ordnance marks plus sold out of service. VGC grips, scabbard and fittings turned grey. GC

24 - '07 BAYONET

NZ Military 1907 bayonet for the SMLE. 43cm blade with some staining. Ordnance marked with 1918 date and Wilkinson makers mark. NZ marked on the hilt. Complete with scabbard. GC

25 - JUNGLE CARBINE BAYONET

No5 MK1 bayonet to suit the Lee Enfield Carbine and Sterling S.M.G. 20cm blued blade marked with pin circle and 1946. VGC wooden grip and steel scabbard. ExC

26 - TWO LEE ENFIELD BAYONETS

A NO4 MKII* bayonet with bakelite scabbard, plus a No9 MKI bayonet and scabbard with frog, both for the No4 rifle.

27 - WALTHER PPK PISTOL

West German Military/Police issue semi auto pistol. 3¼" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with banner logo, Ulm West Germany address and is without Commercial proofs but has twin 952 proofs also on the frame and no markings on the barrel. Metalwork has near all bright blue with slight holster wear to the muzzle and VGC banner logo, black grips and original 7R finger groove magazine. Includes original box and extra magazine. ExWO&C CLR

28 - COLT 1908 PISTOL

Chinese Shanghai Police issue Model 1908 380 Hammerless semi auto pistol, circa 1928. 3¾" .380ACP cal barrel, slide with original sights and Colt markings. Feature the Fairbairn spring modification and also has rack number 696. The frame marked Shanghai Municipal Police and has correct lanyard ring. Metalwork has typical correct reblue and is fitted with Chinese bakelite grips and has the correct magazine with twin counters. VGWO&C CLR

29 - BROWNING 1922 PISTOL

Unusual target variant of the post war FN 1910/22 pistol. 4½" .32ACP cal barrel and one piece slide with factory adjustable sights and marked with Herstal address. Metalwork is in ExC retaining all over bright blue finish with only very minor handling wear. ExC FN logo plastic grips. ExWO&C B/CLR

30 - SIG P75 PISTOL

Swiss Military issue variant of the P220 pistol, circa 1970's. 41/4" 9mm cal barrel, slide with original fixed sights and marked with the Swiss Cross and sig logo as well as 'A' prefix serial number. Metalwork is in ExC retaining near all matte parkerised original finish. ExC black plastic original grips. ExWO&C B/CLR

31 - BROWNING HI-POWER PISTOL

Belgian FN model 1935 pistol, circa 1970's. 4½" 9mm cal barrel, slide with original fixed sights and Herstal address. Metalwork has most all over original blue with holster and handling wear. VGC checkered original wooden grips. G-VGWO&C B/CLR

32 - S&W MODEL 19 REVOLVER

U.S Model 19-3 vintage double action revolver. 3" .357 cal barrel with original fixed sights and marked with calibre plus Smith & Wesson. Frame with logo and 6 shot cylinder. Metalwork has near all original bright blue and case colours with some very minor storage loss in two spots. ExC original walnut grips. ExWO&C CLR

33 - MARTINI HENRY RIFLE

British Volunteer Martini action rifle. 32½" 577/450 cal barrel with bayonet lug on the band and original sights. Marked Soft Foreign Steel Specially Made To Reduce Fouling For Field Rifle Company Birmingham as well as proofs. Action without markings. Metalwork has all over dulling original blue. VGC original woodwork with swivels and rod. VG-ExWO&C ALR

34 - MARTINI ENFIELD RIFLE

NZ Military single shot rifle. 29" .303 cal barrel with original sights and without bayonet lug. The chamber is marked N↑Z 98 with S. Right hand side of the receiver is marked Crown VR ENFIELD 1895 ME 303 and the left has Henry markings for III I. Metalwork has most blue to the barrel with stained patina on the receiver. VGC woodwork with swivels but front one is broken. G-VGWO&C ALR

35 - ARTILLERY CARBINE

NZ Military Martini-Enfield Artillery Carbine MKI. 21" .303 cal barrel with original sights and proofs etc. The chamber is N\u03b4Z 98 marked. The left hand side of the receiver is marked Crown VR Enfield 1897 ME 303 A.C.I and the right has traces of the Henry markings. Metalwork has overall blue turning to dark mottled patina, FC-GC woodwork. GWO&C ALR



36 - SWEDISH ROLLING BLOCK RIFLE

Swedish Military single shot Remington rolling block rifle in 12mm RF calibre. 36½" barrel with original sights and no bayonet lug. Top of chamber marked with factory and Swedish Crown S stamps, receiver shows traces of old case hardening, right side also marked Crown S and 1869 date, original blued barrel, mostly a patchy plum brown patina with some loss at the muzzle and with polished/case hardened trigger guard showing old staining. Brass buttplate numbered to gun as is wooden stock and forend, together with its steel cleaning rod. VGWO&C ALR

37 - PEABODY MARTINI RIFLE

Rare original single shot breech loading Peabody Martini Patent 1870 submitted for trials. Made by the Braendlin Armoury Co Birmingham. 34¾" .450 cal round barrel with Birmingham proofs, Henry's patent and graduated to 1200 on the leaf and 400 on the bed. The receiver with logo and Martinis patent plus has safety catch in front of the large cocking lever and Peabody lever with long body for the 3¼" straight case. Metalwork has turned to a dark brown patina with overall old minor pin pricking. VGC original woodwork with swivels and steel butt plate with trap and includes rod. A scarce and seldom seen rifle. VGWO&C ALR

38 - LONG TOM RIFLE

British/NZ magazine Lee Enfield rifle MKI*. 30" .303 cal barrel with bayonet bar nose cap without cleaning rod hole, rear sight graduated to 600 yards on the bed and marked HV. Chamber BSA and ordnance marked. The wrist marked B.S.A Co., has lobbing sight (also on stock), receiver has magazine cut off. Metalwork has dark original patina with areas of blue. VGC woodwork with NZ marked butt plate. The top wood has old crack. Complete with swivels. VGWO&C ALR

39 - CAVALRY BANDOLIER

British/NZ Military, early 20th Century/WWI MKII Bandolier. 9 cell horizontal grain leather cells and belt with brass triangular connector and buckle. ExC

40 - NZ BALL GRENADE

Rare and unusual NZ marked inert hand grenade, circa WWI-II. Cricket ball shape, approx 3", similar to a No15 hand grenade. Embossed in the casting NZ. The brass top section marked DNZ. VGC NLR

Scarce and desirable late WWII German semi auto rifle. 22" 8mm cal barrel with original fore sight, hood and correct fine machining marks with original rear sight graduated to 1200 meters. The rough cast receiver is marked K43ac44 for Walther 1944 & marked with serial number matching on the charging handle which is Eagle 359 marked for Walther. The right hand side of the receiver is the late war non optic rail type with no provision for the side mount. Metalwork has all over thinning original blue. ExC correct late war laminated stock with chatter marks and bakelite top wood. The stock is mismatched but correct Walther Eagle 359 cartouche and metal butt plate with trap. Includes its correct 10R original magazine marked awj Waffen amt K43 and cleaning rod. ExWO&C P7LR

45 - PPS43 S.M.G

Polish Cold War era variant of the WWII Soviet sub machine gun. 10" 7.62 Tok cal barrel with original shroud and sights. The chamber marked with 12 in oval arsenal mark and 1953 date. Metalwork has all over blued finish with steel folding stock, bakelite grip and includes its 35R magazine. ExWO&C C&P7LR

46 - MG34/42 BELT DRUM

Original WWII belt drum holder for the German machine guns. Near all black finish and code marked ddf. ExC

47 - MG34/42 LINK

Five x 50R original WWII belted link for the German machine guns. ExC $\,$

48 - MG STARTER TAB

Original code and Waffen amt 1940 dated starter tab for the MG34 or 42. $ExC\,$

49 - MG34 SLING

Original WWII leather sling for the German machine gun. VGC code marked ddy42.

50 - MG BELT LOADING MACHINE

Original WWII machine for loading the MG34/42 belts. Four part / piece construction with bench mount hopper and handle. Includes its green post war painted original ammo tin carrier with stripe. ExC

51 - NAMBU TYPE 14 PISTOL

A fine example of an Imperial Japanese pre WWII pistol. 4 ½" 8mm cal barrel with original sight. The right hand side of the frame is marked with Tokyo arsenal mark, serial number in the 14,000 range and Showa 5.8 for August 1930. The left hand side with straw coloured safety and trigger. Metalwork has all over original rust blue finish with some very minor holster staining to a few spots. The cocking handle is correct coarse type as are the ExC original varnished beech grips which have had a period modification with a metal pin to prevent the safety going the wrong direction. The magazine is mismatched but is an ExC Tokyo/Kokura type. Included is its ExC and original type 2 leather holster with cleaning rod and spare firing pin and the original Japanese owners identification booklet. ExWO&C B/CLR

52 - CZ M27 PISTOL

WWII Nazi German Czech semi auto pistol. 3¾" .32ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked on top Bohmische Waffenfabrik with Waffen amt (also on the frame). The side of the slide also with German designation and Kal 7.65. Metalwork has near all overall original blue with some handling and holster wear. ExC original CZ logo bakelite grips. Includes its original P.MOD 27 marked magazine, plus original leather holster and extra magazine. VGWO&C CLR

53 - BERETTA 1934 PISTOL

Italian WWII semi automatic pistol. 3¼" .380ACP cal barrel, the slide with original sights and marked P Beretta etc with 1938-XVI date. The frame with Crown/RE Air force mark and matching serial number. Metalwork has plum finish to the slide and most blue to the frame thinning on the edges and a few areas of speckle staining. VGC original grips, missing firing pin otherwise VGC CLR

54 - WWI SAUER PISTOL

Imperial German Military issue model 1913 semi auto pistol. 3" 7.65 cal barrel slide with original sights and marked JP SAUER & SOHN, SGHL. The frame with imperial proof and military acceptance mark. Metalwork has overall thinning original blue turning dark grey where handled. ExC original hard rubber S&S logo grips. Completed with original spare magazine and holster with extra magazine. VGWO&C CLR

The frame with patent information and 1918 date. Metalwork has original blue to the frame and thinning to dark grey on the barrel, straps and edges of the cylinder. VGC original grips with lanyard ring. GWO&C B/CLR

56 - ENFIELD NO2 MKI REVOLVER

British Military Revolver. 5" .38 S&W cal barrel with original sight and ordnance marks. Frame with Enfield logo, model and 1936 date. Most overall matte Military finish. VGC grooved wooden grips with lanyard ring. Missing firing pin otherwise VGC B/CLR

57 - WEBLEY HOLSTER

Original British Military pattern brown leather flap holster for the WWI MK6 Webley revolver. Private purchase to fit on the Sam Browne belt. GC

The bolt is correct type but mismatched serial number which is matching on the bayonet lug, the second band is unnumbered monopod type. The 3 digit assembly numbers are matching on the barrel and both stock reinforcing sections and wedge (missing two screws). Metalwork has overall blue turning grey on underside. VGC correct woodwork with two piece butt stock with cupped plate and inlet above the swivel. Most likely a late war example. VGWO&C ALR Estimated \$5,000 - \$7,000

62 - TYPE 99 RIFLE

An excellent example of a highly collectable 'last ditch' late WWII Arisaka bolt action short rifle. 25.8" 7.7JAP cal barrel with late war front sight without wings and bayonet lug. The rear sight is basic fixed peep sight (field modified to V). The chamber has mum intact and correctly without model Kanji. The side rail with Kokura arsenal mark. The bolt handle and safety knob are rough basic last ditch type in the grey. Metalwork has near all its late war thin blue finish. ExC original stock with chatter marks, swivels and correct wooden but plate. Hard to find a better example. ExWO&C ALR

63 - WINCHESTER P14 RIFLE

NZ Military WWI Enfield bolt action rifle. 26".303 cal barrel with original sights and bayonet lug. The chamber is NZ marked and is also marked with Winchester W prefix and serial number in the 235,000 range as well as star inside circle proof. The rear sight is the 'F' type fine adjustable with original unmatching serial number struck out. The side rail has British Military acceptance proofs. The bolt number is matching and metalwork has near all overall bright blue. ExC woodwork with original swivels and brass disc, marked on right hand side broad arrow and star over IW in circle and PATT.14. Complete with lobbing sights. ExWO&C ALR

64 - MAUSER K98

WWII Nazi German bolt action 98K rifle. 24" 8mm cal barrel with correct foresight but missing hood and original rear sight and correct late war barrel code. Chamber code marked a r for Mauser Berlin Works and 44 date with Waffen amt and acceptance marks plus serial number (matching on the bolt). Correct late war pressed unnumbered trigger. Metalwork has all over late war thin blue. VGC late laminated stock with H (Army/Heer) mark. VGWO&C ALR

65 - SWEDISH M38 RIFLE

Swedish Military M38 Mauser rifle, modified from M96. 24" 6.5x55 cal barrel with original sights. The chamber with early Mauser Oberndorf manufacture marking and 1900 date. Bolt handle is original straight type and visible serial numbers are matching. Metalwork has overall bright blue and the white metal parts with small armourers repair near the rear swivel. Complete with stock disc, swivels and rod. VGWO&C ALR

66 - PORTUGUESE MAUSER

Model 1904/39 bolt action Military rifle. 24" 8mm cal Military converted (re barrelled) from the 1904 6.5 cal. WWII German Army Paratroopers badge. Zinc construction with gilded wreath and Army Eagle. The diving Eagle has Juncker makers mark. VGC

71 - GLIDER AWARD

Cased WWII Luftwaffe Glider Pilots award. Two piece construction with blackened Eagle and silver wash oak leaf wreath with Swastika. The back of the Eagle marked C E JUNCKER BERLIN S W. Contained in its silk and felt lined original box. VGC

72 - CLOSE COMBAT CLASP

German WWII silver Close Combat award for 25 actions. GC

73 - LONG RANGE DESERT GROUP BADGE

Badge of the famous early WWII Special Forces Unit. Round concave silver construction featuring the scorpion and LRDG. Circular silver pin. VGC

74 - NICHOLSON FLINTLOCK PISTOL

Antique all brass Flintlock Blunderbuss pistol by London gun maker Edmund Nicholson, circa 1670-1710. 71/4" octagonal to round barrel with cannon turns, approximately .77 cal/19 bore. Fitted with flick bayonet plus ramrod guide and wooden rod. The top of the barrel is marked with early tower proofs. The side of the boxlock action is marked Nicholson, London and fitted with top sliding safety. The brass has aged patina with some staining. VGC slab sided grip. VGWO&C NLR

75 - PATRICK FLINTLOCK PISTOL





- 12. POSTAL BIDDERS: PAYMENT MUST BE MADE ON RECEIPT OF INVOICE, Do not wait until you get your permits, delays hold up payment to our vendors.
- 13. FIRST TIME BIDDERS will need to establish a line of credit by supplying credit card details.
- 14. We accept your bids in good faith however bad debts and change of mind are not acceptable. Recovery of debts will be strongly pursued through legal channels.
- 15. If you are bidding on behalf of another person you are responsible for inspecting the item and payment.
- 16. Measurements and weights are only an approximate.
